#1 SAT MATH PREPARATION The SATs are like a roller coaster- scary at first but once you know what to expect, there are no surprises. You will learn about the test layout, what formulas are needed, the types of problems given, when to guess an answer, how to avoid the hidden traps and much, much more. Practice tests will be taken and homework is required in order to successfully complete this course. You will emerge as an experienced rider on the SAT roller coaster to college. #2 SAT VERBAL PREPARATION The SAT verbal section format was revised in March 2005. There are no analogies. However, there is more reading and even an essay writing section. Although different from the test of the past, the key to success on the SAT is the same as it has always been - preparation. This course is designed to familiarize and equip students with the skills to assist them in critical reading passages, as well as grammar and usage questions. It will even teach techniques to effectively tackle the essay component. Students will be expected to complete weekly homework assignments and will be assessed with regular tests. Be prepared. Don't let the actual test be the first time you see the format. This course will run for 8 weeks and is taught by Mr. Inverno.
