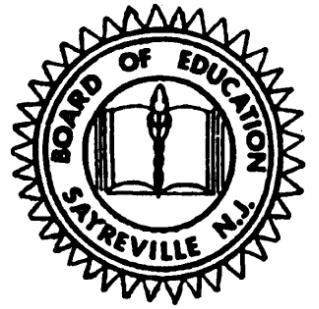

LET THE CHILDREN LEAD PARTICIPANTS

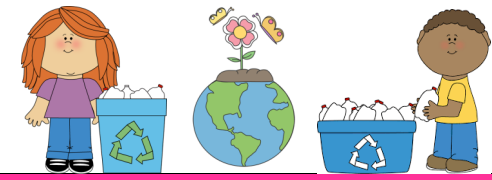
