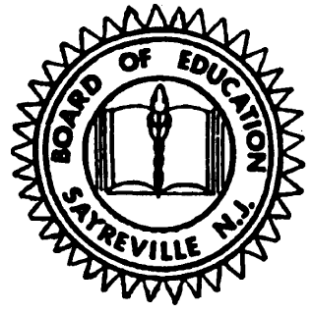

The Sayreville War Memorial High School did extremely well in the WordWright Challenge. The WordWright Challenge is a national reading competition for students in grades 9 through 12 that requires analytical reading of many kinds of prose and poetry. It emphasizes perceptive interpretation, sensitivity to language, and an appreciation of style. More than 64,000 students from some of the best public and private high schools in 48 states participated last year. Our sophomores placed 15th in the nation out of 178 participating teams, and our seniors took 13th place out of 185 participating teams. What an amazing performance!
