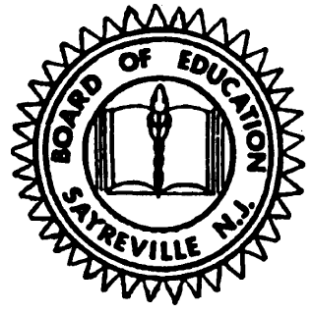

Currently, the varsity football team is 6-1, has won the GMC White Division Title, and will move on to the play-offs. Our cross country teams are doing very well with them both holding a 6-0 record. The boys' varsity soccer team is currently 7-7, rebounding from a 0-2 start, and has qualified for the NJSIAA state tournament for the 16th time in the last 18 seasons. The girls' soccer team has a winning record of 7-4-1 in their division, holding on to second place in the GMC White Division. One other team chasing the GMC White Division title is the SWMHS Girls' Tennis Team, who is 11-0 in conference play. If the Girls' Tennis Team does win the title, it will be their third in a row and Coach Provenza's 10th title. Congratulations to all our Bomber squads; you make us so proud!
