

# Kindergarten and Preschool Registration Begins February 25, 2019

**\*\*\*To be eligible to attend Kindergarten in September 2019, children must be five years old On or Before September 30, 2019. Likewise, to be eligible for preschool, children must be 3 years old On or Before September 30, 2019\*\*\***

On February 25, 2019, parents of ALL eligible (see above) preschool and Kindergarten students are invited to visit our website in order to register for Project Before Preschool or our Full-Day Kindergarten programs via our online registration software. The link to student registration will be clearly identified on our district website homepage ([www.sayrevillek12.net](http://www.sayrevillek12.net)) as "Student Registration". Once on this registration page, you can obtain pertinent information regarding the registration of all students including preschoolers and kindergarteners and you can begin completing the online registration application by clicking on the appropriate link in the 2019-2020 Project Before and Kindergarten text box:

- Students New to Sayreville: New Student Registration Preschool and Kindergarten
- Returning Students: Returning Student Enrollment Update, Grades PreK and Kindergarten

After completing and submitting your application, a representative from Project Before (**for preschool**) or our district Registration Office (**for Kindergarten**) will contact you and schedule an appointment with you in order to verify your residence (**only for Kindergarten and children with preschool disabilities**) and the age of your child, as well as collect all the required documents and information listed below. Soon after that, a representative from the projected school that your child will attend in September will contact you to schedule a time for you to meet so that the school can verify your paperwork.

## What should I bring to my appointment?

For a child to be considered registered, the following completed documents, written or translated in English, must be submitted:

- A certified, original birth certificate, passport or another official document indicating age
- Updated immunization record in English with child's name, doctor or clinic name and month, date and year of shots. Please see website for list of required immunizations
- A copy of the most recent physical examination. The school nurse reviews all health-related documents and will advise parents of additional needs.
- **(Only for Kindergarten or if your child is eligible to receive preschool children with disabilities services)**
  - Proof of Residency with current mortgage payment bill/deed or lease –plus 3 original items from the list below:
    - Current mortgage payment bill/deed or lease
    - Current property tax statement for a home
    - Current utility bill with name and address
    - Photo ID of parent/guardian with current address
    - Paid rent receipts or cancelled rent checks
    - Bank or credit card statement
    - Current automobile registration or insurance card
    - If you are residing with another family – Provide the above proofs of residency and a notarized letter from the Sayreville resident along with their current mortgage payment bill/deed or lease , listing by name all of the registrant's family that certifies the registrants are living in their residence.
- **If your child is registering for Kindergarten, you must bring him or her for a brief kindergarten screening.**
