2018-2019 Goals & Highlights

▶ GOALS:

- ▶ To increase the number of students who are meeting expectations in Algebra I as evidenced by 41 or more of the students who were previously approaching expectations on the 2019 PARCC Algebra I assessment. **(Increased 56%)**
- ▶ To effectively implement the Medal of Honor Character Education Program. **(Infused into Grade 6 – 8 Social Studies Courses)**

▶ HIGHLIGHTS:

- ▶ Implement instructional methods which focus on centers/stations **(Mathematics)**
 - ▶ (Differentiated instruction)
- ▶ Began the infusion on the Medal of Honor Character Education Program in Social Studies Courses
- ▶ Rutgers Climate Project: The inception of the School Climate Team **(Established)**
 - ▶ 30 Students selected by their teachers by grade level
 - ▶ Purpose – to give our students a voice for change
- ▶ Began to identify facility needs (Face Lift) of SMS to continue to support the academic and culture needs of the school. **(Cafeteria Floor, Gym Floor, Sound Systems, Paint, Security System, Locker Rooms, School Store, etc.)**

2. **To decrease the number of chronically absent students by developing and implementing classroom and building-based strategies and activities integrated where applicable with I&RS/RTI.**
