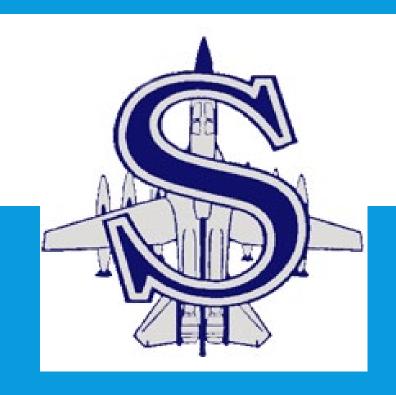
# SAYREVILLE FOOD SERVICES DEPARTMENT FEEDING ONE CHILD AT A TIME
