2018-2019 Goals & Highlights

GOALS:

- ► To increase the number of students who are meeting expectations in Algebra I as evidenced by 41 or more of the students who were previously approaching expectations on the 2019 PARCC Algebra I assessment.
- ► To effectively implement the Medal of Honor Character Education Program.

► HIGHLIGHTS:

- **▶** Implement instructional methods which focus on centers/stations
 - **▶** (Differentiated instruction)
- **▶** Began the infusion on the Medal of Honor Character Education Program in Social Studies Courses
- **▶** Rutgers Climate Project: The inception of the School Climate Team
 - ▶ 30 Students selected by their teachers by grade level
 - ► Purpose to give our students a voice for change
- **▶** Began to identify facility needs (Face Lift) of the school to continue to support the academic and culture needs of the school.
