The number one objective in all Recreational Games is SAFETY

Regular Kickball and Wiffle Ball

- Kickball is a team game that uses an indoor soccer ball and bases
- Wiffle ball is a team game that consists of a bat and ball, usually a plastic curing ball
- Positions include: first base, second base, shortstop, third base, pitcher, catcher, outfield
- Throwing the bat is an automatic out as well as a force out at first base and a runner tagged by a fielder who has the ball
- If a ball is caught in the air or off the wall or ceiling, the batter is out
- A player may **not** throw a ball at a runner in either game
- A player may **not** steal or bunt in either game
- There are **three** outs per team per inning in both games
- A player may tag up on a fly ball that is caught
- A runner may **not** take a lead in either game
- A double play consists of getting two outs within the same play

Two Pitch Kickball, Indoor Soccer, Ultimate Frisbee

- There are 4 bases used in two pitch kickball
- A player may not use their hands in indoor soccer
- Illegal contact means that a player uses force on another player and is not allowed
- Three people are allowed on one base at a time in two pitch kickball
- Ultimate Frisbee is a fast-paced game that uses a flying disc

Boccer

- Boccer consists of soccer and basketball
- A basket in boccer is 1 points and a goal in boccer is 2 point
- If a player commits illegal contact in boccer, a free kick is the result
- A player may NOT self-pass in boccer
- A player may take a MAXIMUM of 3 steps with the ball
- Boccer starts off with a jump ball
- A player may kick the ball up to his/herself using the wall ONLY
- A player may only hold the ball for 3 seconds
