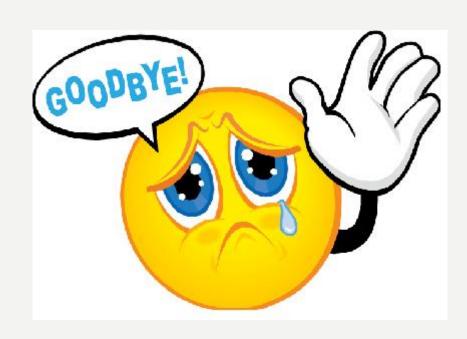

SPECIAL EDUCATION ROUTES

SAYREVILLE

5 buses are currently being used for the High School & 5 buses for Middle School.

I I mini buses are currently being used for the Samsel Upper Elementary School & all four Elementary Schools.

4 buses are currently being used for the mid day run for Project Before at the Samsel Upper Elementary School.

NON-PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS AND NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS We currently transport students to our non-public schools and also provide buses to our vocational schools.

We have 9 Sayreville buses and 3 contracted buses for a total of 312 students we use to transport our non-public school children.

We also contract 7 buses for a total of 136 students to transport them to the various vocational schools.

AID IN LIEU OF TRANSPORTATION

AID IN LIEU IS THE REIMBURSEMENT OF TRANSPORTATION COSTS WHERE NO TRANSPORTATION IS AVAILABLE TO NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS. WE CURRENTLY HAVE 232 STUDENTS WHO RECEIVE THIS REIMBURSEMENT.

ESC ROUTES

Educational Services Commission provides transportation for our Out Of District students.

WE HAVE A TOTAL OF 22 ESC ROUTES. 17 ARE SPECIAL ED. ROUTES AND 5 ARE DISPLACED/COURT ORDERED ROUTES

29 students are on the Special Ed. Route and 10 are on the Displaced/Court Ordered Route.
