What is a Special Education Parent Advisory Group (SEPAG)

- Required by state regulation
 - •NJAC 6A:14-1.2(h): Each district board of education shall ensure that a special education parent advisory group is in place in the district to provide input to the district on issues concerning students with disabilities.
 - oParent driven partnership with district staff
 - •SEPAG membership should be diverse and inclusive
 - •Advises school administrators on system-level needs on behalf of all students with disabilities, not just a single group or a single issue.
 - oHelps to shape the development of programs and services, and policies
 - oUltimately improves district culture and climate


