By June 2022, to increase the percentage of 6th grade mathematics students who will demonstrate growth to meet or exceed expectations evidenced by data from the pre LinkIt Form C (20-21) and post (21-22) LinkIt assessment comparisons (Average Baseline is 20%) to demonstrate readiness for the next grade level. Subgroup: Increase of (+3 or more points)
- 2. To leverage classroom and building-based strategies and activities including integrated where applicable with I&RS/RTI to decrease the number of chronically absent students.
