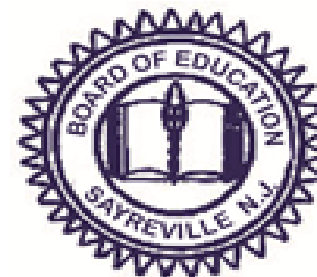

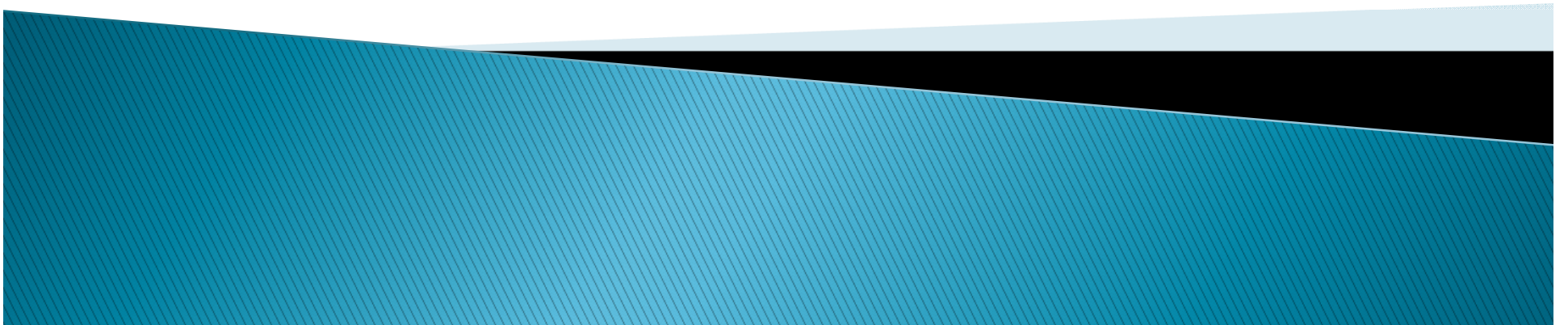

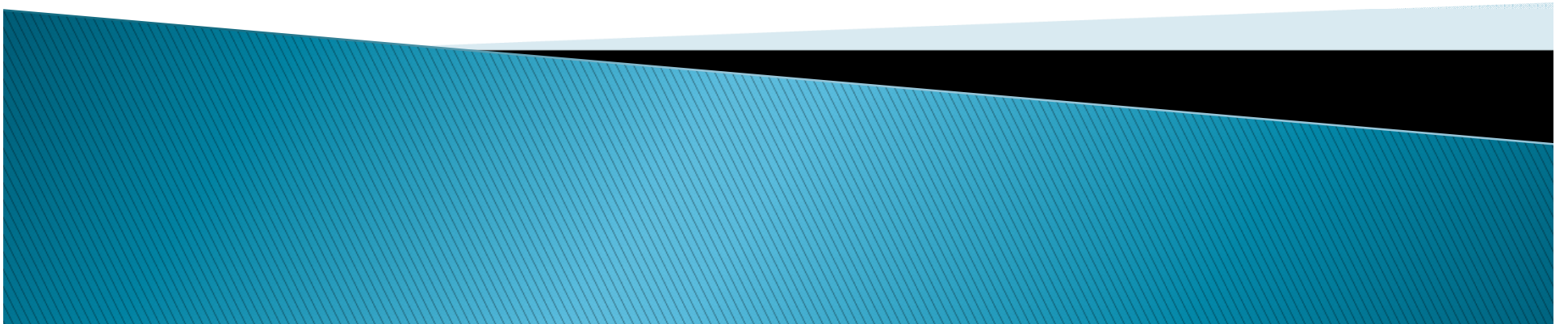


PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT
