## Sayreville War Memorial High School Accomplishments/Highlights 2019-2020

- Re-envisioned the traditional graduation ceremony and hand delivered over 400 diplomas to individual student homes.
- In collaboration with our FBLA students and school committee, we now have an extensive business
  plan for our new SWMHS school store. Our committee goal is to have the school store Grand Opening
  this spring.
- Creation and implementation of the STEM Academy and Career and Technical Education Program (CTE).
  - 25 student total enrollment
  - Established Computer Honor Society
  - Received grant from the Technical Student Association to sponsor a membership for 10 students and 1 advisor.
- SWMHS received reaccreditation by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.
- SWMHS held its first annual Freshman Class "Tip Off" in January, where 8<sup>th</sup> grade students were invited to attend our High School Club and Activity Fair and attend a varsity basketball game.
- The creation of the "Voices of the World Club".
- SWMHS was named a "National Unified Champion School" by the Special Olympics and ESPN.

## Goals for the 2020-2021 School Year

- To continue to enhance intelligence pertaining to potential threats to the school and or students and staff.
- To expand the Computer Science Track within the STEM Academy at Sayreville War Memorial High School. The study of computer science offers students opportunities to develop computational thinking skills that can be applied to problem solving in many disciplines as well as in activities of daily living.
  - By June 30, 2021 student enrollment would increase in the Computer Science Track by 50%.
- Creation of the Inclusion, Diversity, Equality, and Awareness Council.
  - The IDEA council mission is to work with staff and students to promote a positive school culture of equality, equity, and inclusion.

## Goals/Resources/School Improvement for the 2021-2022 School Year
